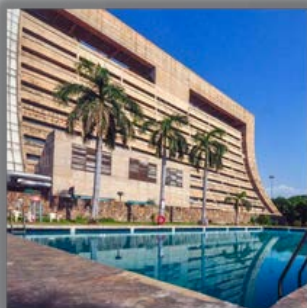

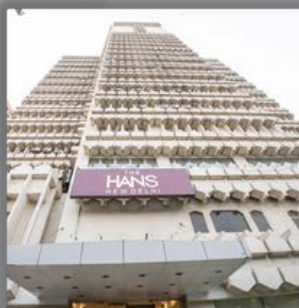

A Taste of Delhi

Pocket friendly eateries which are the favourite of Delhiites

- **Rajinder Da Dhaba** – Safdarjung Enclave . A legendary spot serving North Indian delights like kebabs, mutton korma, and butter chicken. Originally a roadside dhaba, it's now a bustling semi-open joint with quick service and hearty portions. Approx ₹600 for two.
- **Indian Coffee House** – Connaught Place. A nostalgic, no-frills eatery offering South Indian staples like dosas, idlis, and filter coffee. The retro vibe and pocket-friendly menu make it a favorite among students and old-timers alike. Meals under ₹500 for two.
- **Kake Da Hotel** – Connaught Lane. Known for its rich Mughlai fare—think saag gosht, keema kaleji, and butter naan. It's crowded, chaotic, and absolutely worth it. A full meal for two costs around ₹400.
- **Fateh Ki Kachori** – Civil Lines. A humble street stall famous for its spicy kachoris topped with tangy chutneys. It's a local favorite for a quick, flavorful snack that hits the spot. Expect to spend ₹50–₹100 per person.
- **Old and Famous Jalebiwala** – Chandni Chowk. Serving piping hot jalebis since 1884, this iconic sweet shop is a must-visit. The jalebis are thick, syrupy, and best enjoyed fresh off the pan. Around ₹30–₹60 per serving.
- **Noora Nihari** – Sadar Bazaar. A hidden gem for slow-cooked nihari, served with soft khameeri rotis. The flavors are deep and comforting—perfect for meat lovers seeking authenticity. Meals under ₹200 per person.
- **Parashar Foods** – Connaught Place. Famous for rajma chawal with a twist—served with papad and salad. It's a quick-service joint ideal for a filling lunch on the go. ₹100–₹150 per plate.
- **Jung Bahadur Kachori Wala** – Chandni Chowk. This tiny stall dishes out crispy kachoris with spicy aloo sabzi. It's a classic Old Delhi experience, best enjoyed standing elbow-to-elbow with fellow foodies. ₹50–₹80 per serving.

- **Shyam Sweets** – Chawri Bazar. Known for bedmi puri and nagori halwa—a breakfast combo that's spicy, sweet, and soul-warming. ₹80–₹120 per plate.
- **Natraj Dahi Bhalla** – Chandni Chowk. Serving soft dahi bhallas and crisp aloo tikkis since 1940. Light, tangy, and refreshing. ₹60–₹100 per serving.
- **Bhogal Chole Bhature** – Janpath. A humble eatery dishing out fluffy bhature with spicy chole. Perfect for a quick lunch near Connaught Place. ₹80–₹120 per plate.

Ugrasen / Agrasen ki Baoli

A hidden 14th-century stepwell tucked away behind Connaught Place. With its steep red-stone steps and eerie, echoing chambers, it's popular among photographers and history buffs seeking a quiet, atmospheric retreat in the city centre



Jahaz Mahal

Named the "Ship Palace" due to its reflection in the adjacent water body, this 14th-century structure in Mehrauli offers serene architectural charm away from the usual tourist trail

Satpula Seven-Arched Bridge/Dam

An ancient water-harvesting system built by Muhammad bin Tughlaq, featuring seven arched bridges. Located near Khirki Village, it's a tranquil ruin blending medieval engineering with leafy surroundings



Tughlaqabad Fort

Often bypassed by visitors, this vast ruined fortress features formidable walls, buried bastions, a stepwell and hidden tunnels. Offers incredible sunset views and a sense of eerie solitude

Sanjay Van (Forest & Lake)

Spread over 780 acres near Vasant Kunj, this urban forest is a rare green lung in South Delhi. It's ideal for birdwatching, walking trails and discovering ancient ruins tucked in dense foliage

Mehrauli Archaeological Park

A sprawling 200-acre zone dotted with over 100 historical monuments including the Jamali-Kamali Tomb, Rajon Ki Baoli and Balban's tomb. Packed with local history yet largely unexplored by tourists



Mirza Ghalib ki Haveli

The poet Ghalib's 19th-century residence in Chandni Chowk, now a museum. Preserved in Mughal style, it displays his handwritten poems and artifacts, evoking a quiet, reflective literary atmosphere

Rajaon Ki Baoli

A deep four-storey Lodhi-era stepwell built by masons—'Rajaon'. Its symmetrical plunge into the earth offers calm shade, intriguing architecture and peaceful solitude away from the crowds



Chor Minar

The so-called "Tower of Thieves" in Hauz Khas: a 13th-century minaret with 225 holes where Alauddin Khalji reputedly displayed criminals' heads. Now surrounded by greenery, it's both eerie and historically captivating

Sulabh International Museum of Toilets

This unique and quirky museum in Mahavir Enclave traces sanitation through centuries and cultures - from Harappan era toilets to royal privies. Informative, social commentary driven and surprising in equal measure
