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Special Incentive Scheme of Masonic Eye Center (MEC)

Dear Brethren,

The Masonic Eye Centre at Janpath is equipped with state-of-the-art machines and qualified doctors and technicians. It has a modular operation theater in which cataract operations are being conducted. The Center also has a Mobile Eye Clinic which is fully equipped with machines. The van is used to hold eye check-up camps at various locations in Delhi NCR to provide relief to citizens from slums and low-income group colonies.

RW Bro Puneet Sohal, RW the Regional Grand Master, in order to increase the participation of the Lodges and Masonic bodies in Delhi NCR, launched the Special Incentive Scheme in 2025 to hold Camps in partnership with the Masonic Eye Center. Since then, 22 camps have been organized with the initiative of 26 Lodges in which more than 3500 patients have benefited.

Aim of the Scheme:

1. To increase participation of Lodges and Masonic bodies in holding Eye-checkup camps
2. To take the services of the MEC Janpath to the doors of underprivileged and needy.

Details of the special scheme:

The scheme is a collaboration of MEC Janpath and the Lodges/Masonic bodies.

1. Role of MEC Janpath:
 - a. Provide technical support – doctors, technicians, machines etc.
 - b. General spectacles for free distribution to needy.
 - c. Registration forms.
 - d. Follow-up services at MEC, Janpath.
2. Role of the Lodges (single or a group) and Masonic bodies:
 - a. Identify location of camp. It should be place where persons from economically weaker sections and under-privileged are present. The venue may be in a religious place, local community center, school or any other accessible place

where 40 to 50 persons can be accommodated along with tables for 4-5 doctors and technicians.

- b. Local publicity by banners, leaflets and other media;
- c. Invitation to a local eminent personality(ies).
- d. Arrange furniture, tents and electricity etc.
- e. Electrical connection to provide power to medical equipment as per MEC requirements and for fans;
- f. Management of registration process through brethren and ladies of Lodge(s);
- g. Snacks, tea and drinking water for doctors, technicians, patients, attendants and the members of the Lodge.
- h. Lunch for doctors, technicians and the members of the Lodge.
- i. Follow-up with the patients identified for cataract surgery and coordination with MEC Janpath. The Lodges may have to arrange for the travel of the patients and their relatives to MEC Janpath.

Expenditure:

- 1. The MEC Janpath shall provide technical services **free of cost**.
- 2. The expenses for the local arrangements at the venue shall be borne by the Lodges/bodies.
- 3. Cataract surgeries at the MEC Janpath shall be done free of cost as these are sponsored by various brethren.
- 4. The Lodges/bodies are welcome to contribute for the surgeries (Rs. 3000/- per surgery) as well as the services provided by the MEC Janpath at the camp.

The Lodges/Masonic bodies are invited to organize Eye check-up camps. While the camps are generally held on Sundays, during the UBD month of June these can be held on other days also, but with prior notice of at least 10 days.
